

Clerk's Report for January 26

Playing Field:

- The tree's have been planted behind the playing field fence.
- The replacement fence panels have been delivered and we hope to have these installed as soon as possible.
- The chain links on the large single point swing have excessive wear and when investigating the option for taking the links out it was found that the bearing in the assembly unit is failing. Costs are being obtained to replace the sealed unit.
- We have again experienced damage to the fencing at the entrance to Penny Darn.
- The CCTV has been serviced and the order for replacement cameras has been given.
- Bolts from the play area fencing have been removed. Staff have been provided with an order number to obtain replacements.

Cemetery:

- 1 new memorial permit has been issued.
- The CCTV system has been serviced and the order for a replacement camera has been given.
- A bush has been removed following recent bad weather.

General:

- The Budget report has been published.
